

Editor's note

The SAJCN archive back to 2004 has now been completed by the joint publishers of the SAJCN, Taylor and Francis (T&F) and MedPharm. The remainder archive is in the process of being transferred with, clearly, the aim of having it completed the soonest possible during the course of the year. SAJCN functionality has overall been maintained and the SAJCN can be accessed, in its new format via the Medpharm portal: <http://medpharm.tandfonline.com>.

On the T&F site, users will also be able to see the most read articles, as well as articles published ahead of a given SAJCN print edition. The redesigned Taylor & Francis Online platform, launched on Tuesday 9th August, provides academics access to information in a simple and clearly structured format with a significantly improved interface, an elevated level of search and readability, and clear SAJCN branding. The key improvements on the Taylor & Francis Online platform include:

- **Greater discoverability:** multi-faceted search for finding articles and journals in a simple and fast way with options to filter by subject, publication date and access options.
- **More prominent journal branding:** Journal titles and covers are elevated and Journal pages offer an improved display of related and key content, making it easier for readers to identify and access the SAJCN.
- **More intuitive and readable article layout:** A new article display organises figures and data, references, citations and article statistics into tabs, plus highlights reader's access options and the article PDF.
