For those without internet access, the completed questionnaire can be torn out and posted to the address indicated in the CPD form. Please remember to sign the document and provide a r*eliable, accurate and functional* fax number/postal address in order to receive your processed certificate. As always, a new system is only as good as the feedback one receives on its functionality.
